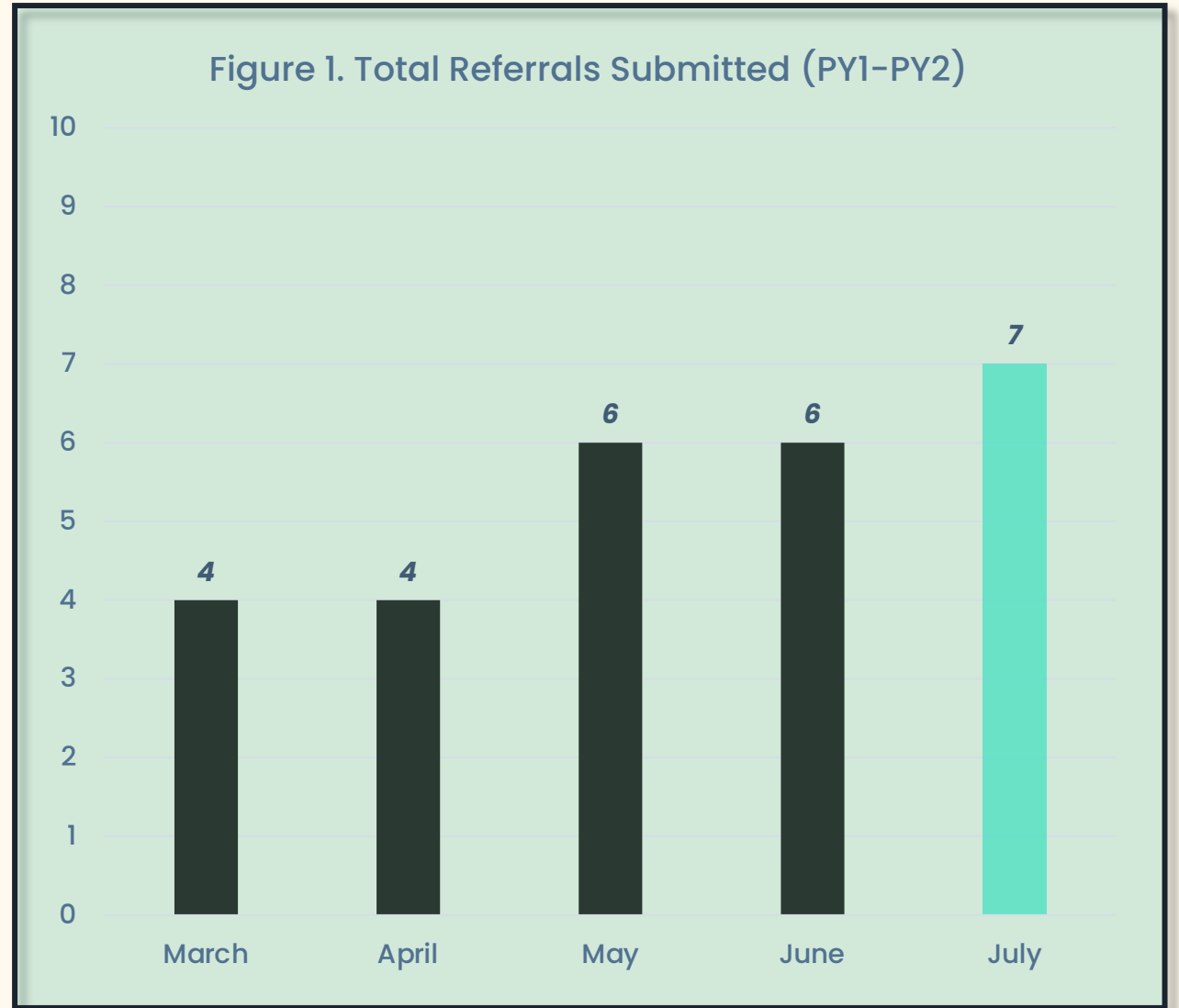
CROP Focus and Goals

Program Overview

The Mississippi Public Health Institute's Congregational Recovery Outreach Program (MSPHI-CROP) aims to reduce racialized behavioral health disparities by partnering with three Hinds County congregations (Jackson Revival Center, Pearl Street AME Church, and New Horizons Church International) and the local mental health provider (Hinds Behavioral Health Services).

CROP *REFERRALS*

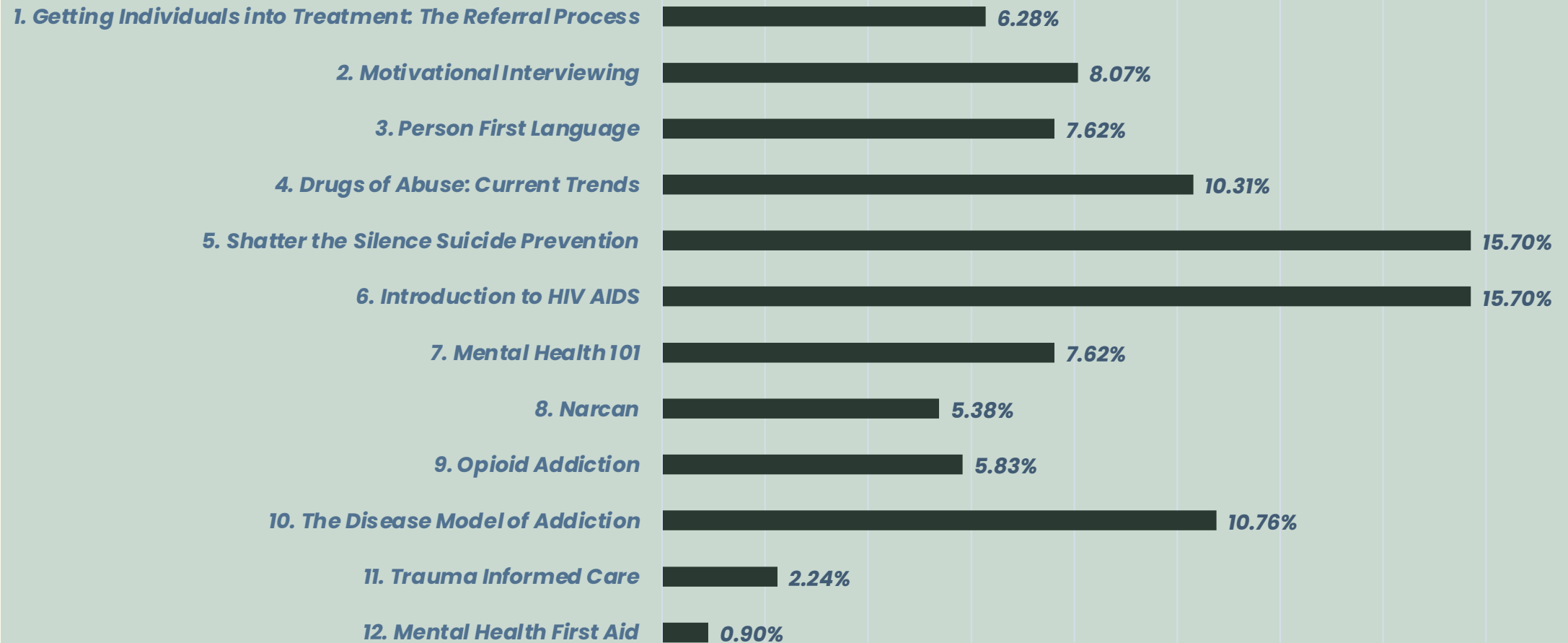
A total of 20 referrals were made by CROP congregations between March 1 and June 30 of 2022. Referrals were directed to Hinds Behavioral Health Services (HBHS). Two of those 20 referrals were subsequently forwarded to external providers by HBHS (Region 6 and Harbor House).

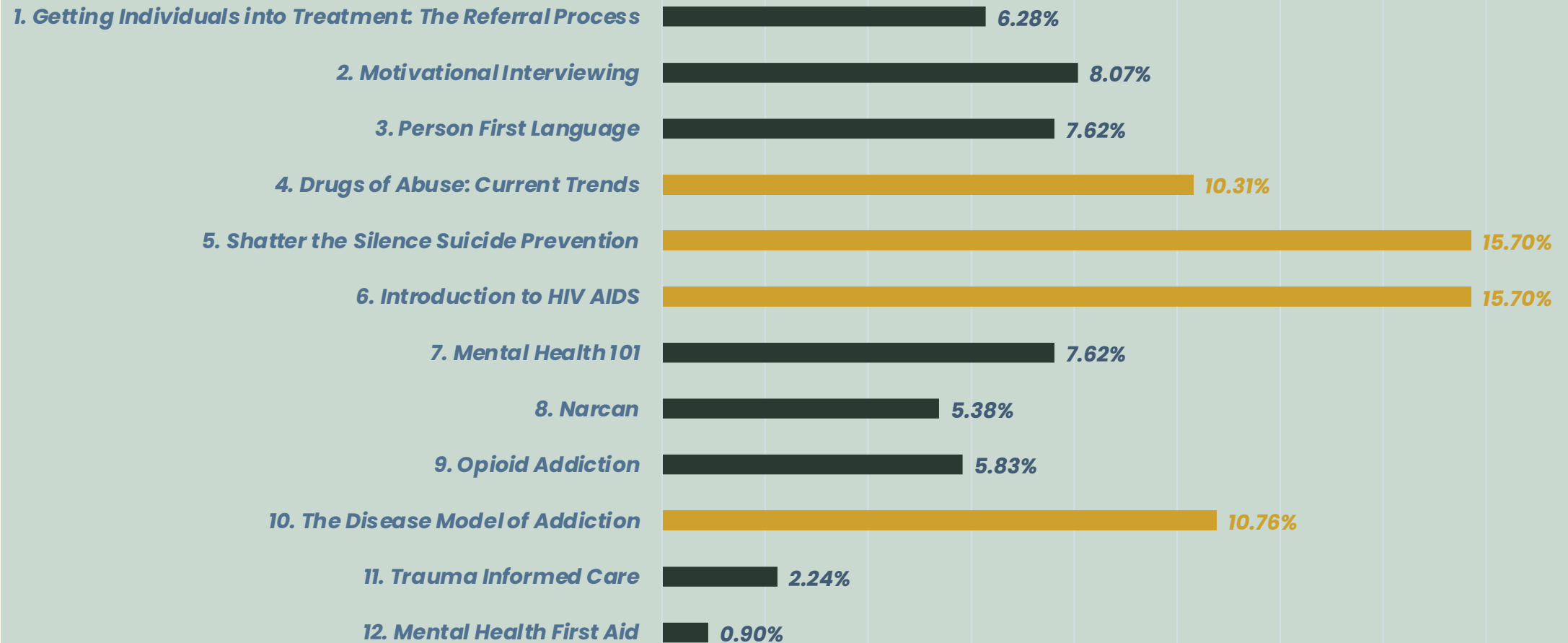
Figure 2. Percentage of All CROP Trainees Who Attended Specific Trainings

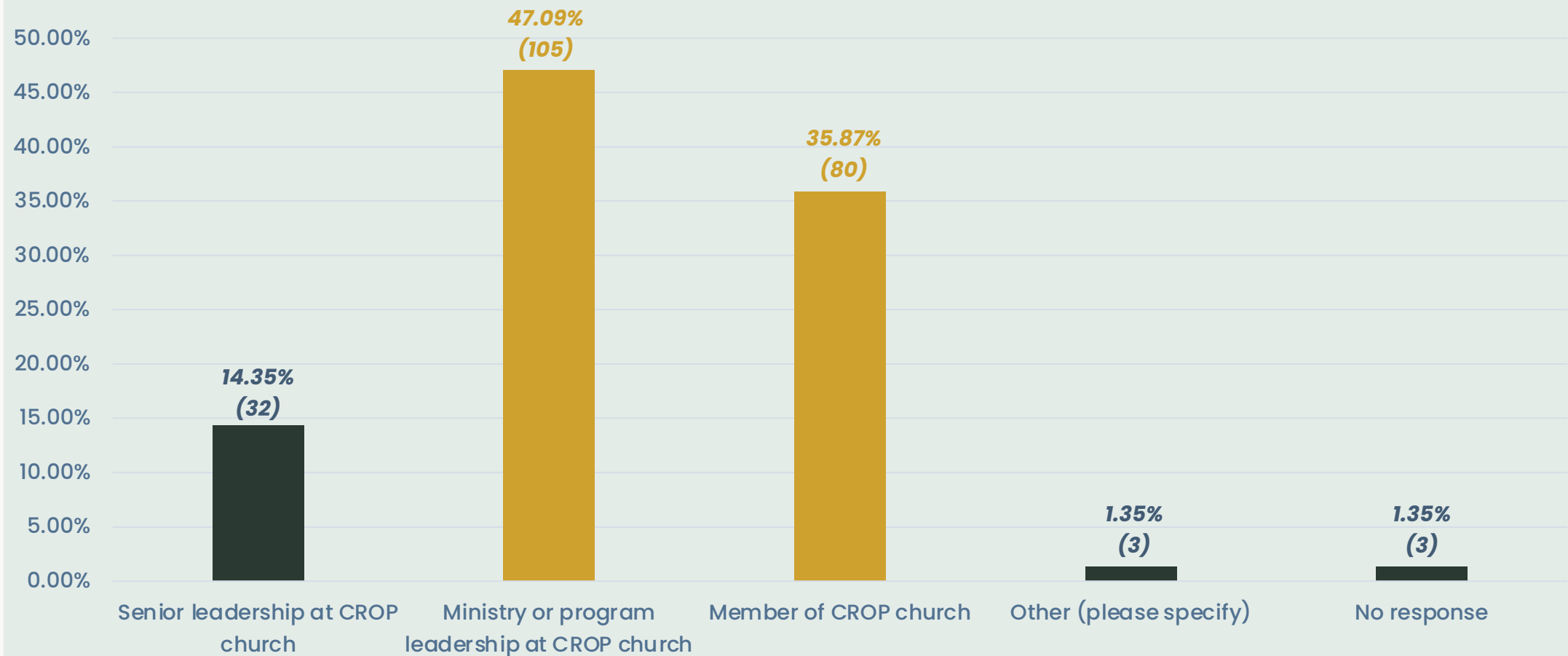
Figure 2. Percentage of All CROP Trainees Who Attended Specific Trainings

Figure 3. Congregational Roles

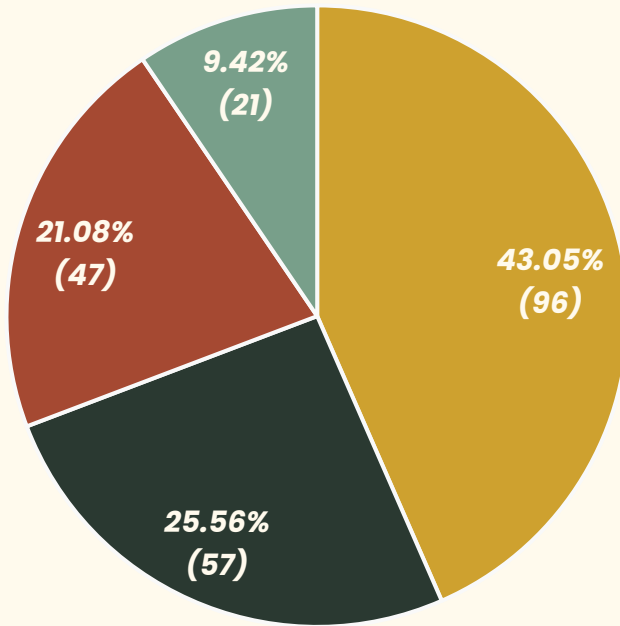

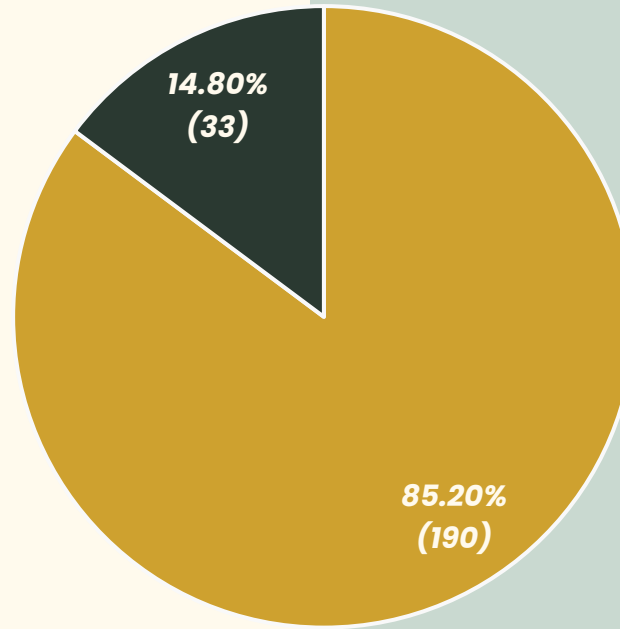
Figure 4. Age

- 40-under 18 years old

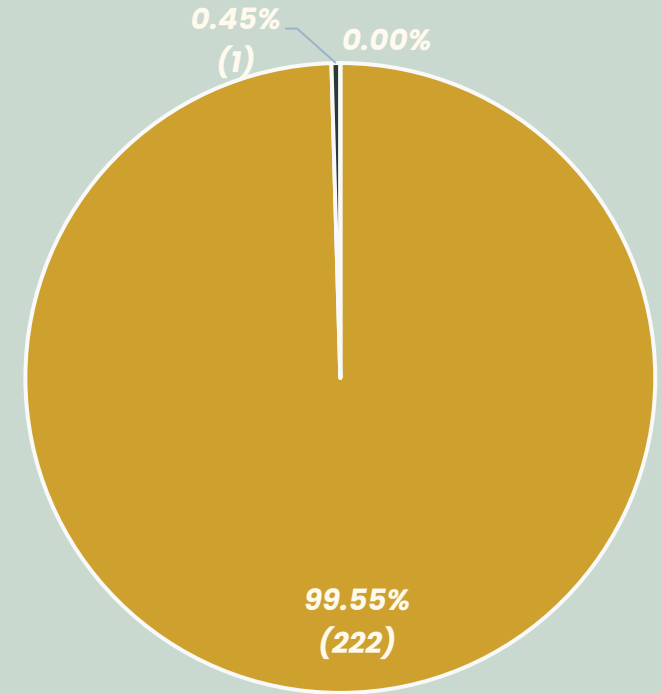

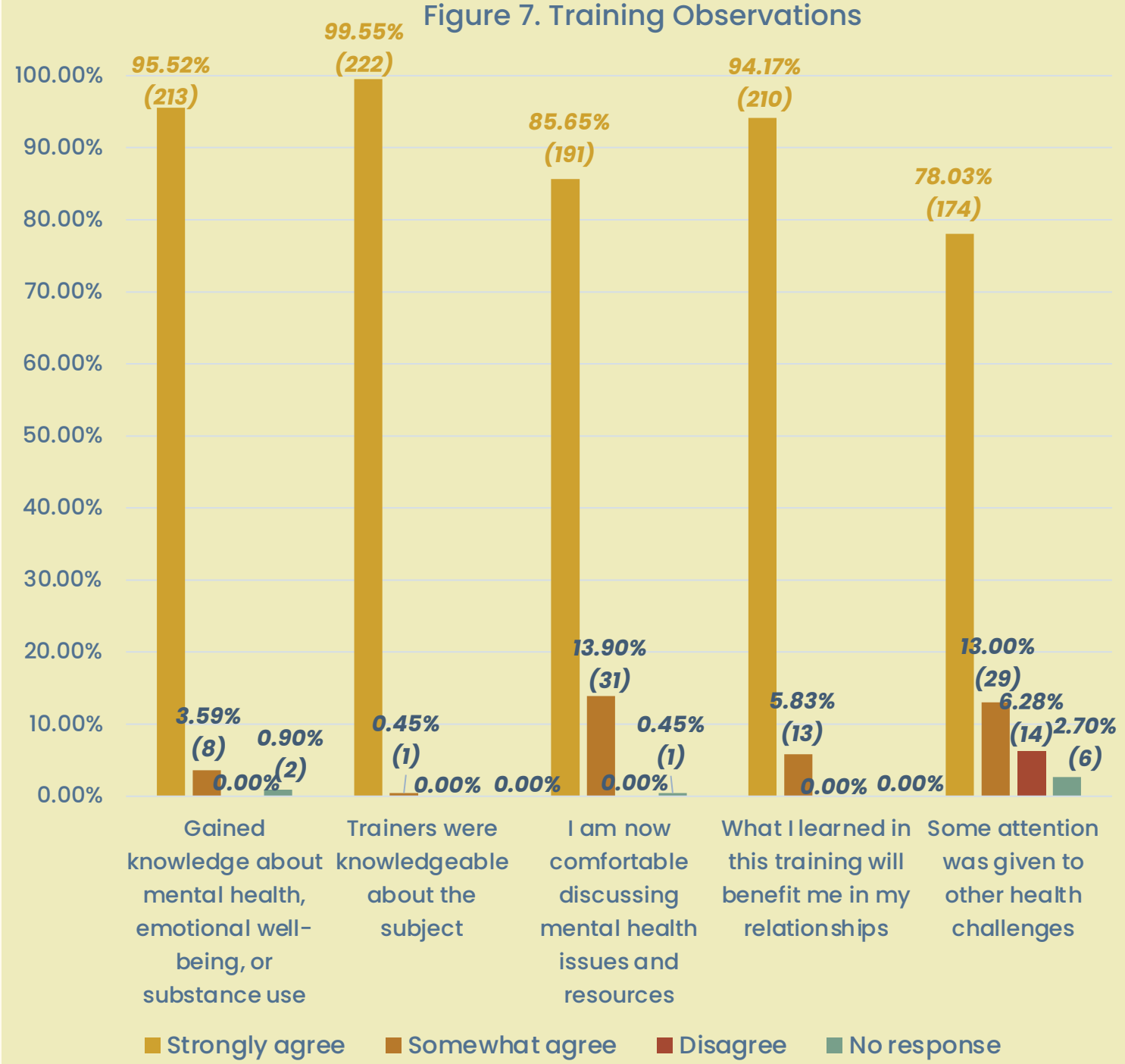
